

General Pre Nursing Requirements

SIUE will be offering a traditional bachelor's- level nursing program on the Carbondale campus in the fall of 2010. Application to the SIUE Nursing program on either the Carbondale or Edwardsville campus for the fall semester should be made between Sept 15 and March 1. The minimum grade point required to apply is 2.7 on a 4.0 scale. Realistically, students should have at least a 3.2 to be competitive. Students must take the HESI Admission Assessment (A2) given at SIUC through Testing Services.
