

General Pre Nursing Requirements

Application to the SIUE Nursing program on either the Carbondale or Edwardsville campus for the fall semester should be made between Sept 15 and March 1. The minimum *prerequisite* grade point required to apply is 2.7 on a 4.0 scale (2.5 cumulative). Realistically, students should have at least a 3.2 GPA to be competitive. Students must take the HESI Admission Assessment (A2) given at SIUC through Testing Services. PREREQUISITE COURSES (*SIUE/C & UIC*) Prerequisite courses must be passed with a C or better and a cumulative GPA of 2.7 on a 4.0 scale for SIU. For UIC, three out of the five natural science courses must be completed prior to application to the program.
